#### Additional Information for Roza's Emergency Drought Application for SVID water

APR 15 2024

**Summary:** Roza is leasing up to 5,000 acre feet of water from SVID. SVID is running an application Ecology process for their growers. This gives growers the opportunity to fallow lands for the 2024 irrigation gional Office season rather than grow a crop. The criteria/requirements for a grower to participate include:

- A 3-acre minimum to participate.
- All land in the program must be fallowed no alternative sources of water can be used to irrigate the land for the 2024 irrigation season.
- The land must have been irrigated in the 2023 irrigation season.

SVID will monitor the acres to ensure that no fallowed land is irrigated. (Lease application and Fact sheet are attached)

This process was conducted during the 2015 drought and was approved through an Order Pendente Lite (OPL) in the Aquavella Adjudication. It went through the court in 2015 because the final decree had not been issued (see attached). Leases were also conducted in 1994, 2001 and 2005.

The deadline to submit the application is April 19<sup>th</sup>. A spreadsheet that includes all the fallowed acres will be submitted to Ecology on April 22, 2024.

**Existing Point of Diversion**: 130 feet south and 1,500 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 28, being within the NW¼SE¼ of Section 28, T. 12 N., R. 19 E.W.M. (Sunnyside Dam and the headworks of the Sunnyside Canal)

**New Point of Diversion:** 950 feet, S 3° 30' west (approximately 975 feet south and 75 feet west) from the northeast corner of Section 32, being within the NE1/4NE1/4 of Section 32, T. 15 N., R. 19 E.W.M.

**Consumptive Use Calculation:** The leased water's use is for the same purpose of use and both districts have similar crop types. A consumptive use analysis was not done in the 2015 OPL

Period of use: May 1, 2024 - October 31, 2024

Please note that the quantity of water (up to 5,000 acre-feet) is calculated from the time period of May 1 – September 30. The water can be used until October 31. The fields will be fallowed from May 1 – the end of the irrigation season.

**Target Flows:** Target flows within the Roza Reach that were established under the Interim Comprehensive Basin Operating Plan for the Yakima Project (November 2002) will be met.

The leased water's use is for the same purpose of use and both districts have similar crop types. A consumptive use calculation isn't needed for this emergency authorization. It wasn't done in the 2015 OPL.

There are multiple irrigation methods on the Roza Irrigation District, including but not limited to, drip, overhead, circle. This water will be conveyed through the Roza Canal

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Roza Irrigation District is leasing up to 5,000 acre-feet of water from Sunnyside Valley Irrigation District (SVID).

This is an upstream point of diversion change for the 2024 irrigation season only. Water will be moved from the SVID point of diversion to the Roza point of diversion. A similar change was approved through the Aquavella court in, 1994, 2001, 2005 and 2015 under an Order Pende Lite. Minimum Instream Flows in the Roza Reach will be met.

In April of 2024, SVID ran an application process for their growers to fallow lands to transfer water to Roza. The following criteria are required for a SVID grower to participate: a minimum of 3 acres of land, the land had to be irrigated the previous irrigation season (2023), and once enrolled in the program, the lands must be fallowed. Water cannot be applied to participating lands from any source. Compliance will be monitored by SVID.

The volume of water temporarily transferred will be adjusted according to the level of proation required in the Sunnyside Divion. The water volumes will be reviewed and adjusted monthly or more frequently based on the adjusted Sunnyside diversions from the Yakima River.

It is anticipated that the water will be used at the end of the irrigation season in order to stretch the season out as long as possible. Again, target flows in the Roza Reach will be met.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Dept. of Ecology Central Regional Office

- Q. What will happen to my water right?
- A. There will be no change in water rights as a result of a transfer. You simply transfer your SVID water allotment to RID for the 2024 irrigation season.
- Q. When do I get my money?
- A. You will be receiving your funds from RID at the rate of \$300 per acre foot within ten days of the effective date of the transfer once all approvals have been received. The anticipated date of approval is May 1, 2024. All questions on payment will be directed to RID.
- Q. I have a one acre piece, can I transfer?
- A. No, RID has set a 3 acre minimum to participate.
- Q. I want to transfer my water to a friend on RID.
- A. There are no direct transfers between individual landowners to RID from individual landowners in SVID. Transfers from farmer to farmer are prohibited. RID has requested the transfers to be done in bulk in order to be manageable by RID.
- Q. Can I still water my land with an alternative source(s)?
- A. No. Once enrolled in the program, the land must be fallowed. Water cannot be applied to participating lands from any source. Non-compliance with this policy will result in your cancellation from the program, suspension on any payment of funds from RID, and request for refund of payment already made.
- Q. What if I have already watered my land, can I still participate in the transfer?
- A. Yes, but at the time you submit your application the land must be fallowed for the rest of the 2024 irrigation season.
- Q. Can I put multiple parcels on one agreement?
- A. Yes, provided they are contiguous.
- Q. Can you just subtract my assessment from my payment?

- A. No, the parcel assessment must be paid in full before the process can proceed. RID will be the entity to make the payment to the landowner, not SVID.
- Q. Can I sell/transfer a portion of my parcel and keep enough to water my lawn?
- A. This is the only case where we will allow a portion of a parcel to be transferred, but the amount retained must be ½ acre and irrigated by a well.
- Q. I have Konewock land, can I transfer my water?
- A. No, Konewock Ditch Company and Piety Flat Ditch Company landowners cannot participate in the program. This is for SVID lands only.
- Q. My land is within the City, can I transfer my water.
- A. No.
- Q. If I did not water the parcel last year am I allowed to transfer the water allotment to RID?
- A. No, the land has to have been irrigated in 2023 to participate in the program.
- Q. If I fill out an application will I be guaranteed to be in the program?
- A. No. Transfer applications will be accepted between April 9 and close of business on April 19. If applications meet all of the requirements and are approved by all authorities, they will be in the program.

THIS AGREE	MENT is executed by Sunnyside Valle	ey Irrigation District ("SVID") and

SVID with an appurtenant water right described on attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein totaling \_\_\_\_\_\_ acres.

**WHEREAS**, the Yakima River Basin is in 2024 experiencing drought conditions which have been recognized by the U.S. and Washington State; and

WHEREAS, conditional, temporary, drought condition inter-district transfers of irrigation water to supplement reduced, prorated primary irrigation water entitlements are, subject to prior SVID Director approval and possible concurrence by U.S. and Washington State agencies; and

WHEREAS, it may be possible on a case-by-case basis with prior SVID Board approval, and subject to this "Agreement", the specific conditions of SVID's Resolution 2024-03-01, and SVID policies, regulations, resolutions and rules to permit and limit the transfer and use of SVID irrigation water as a temporary, supplemental supply outside SVID's boundaries without adversely affecting SVID's ability to efficiently operate the Sunnyside Division's irrigation and drainage facilities, or adequately and timely water deliveries or water rights of Sunnyside Division landowners / water users.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, covenants and conditions herein and other valuable consideration, the undersigned agree to the temporary drought condition <u>prorata</u> transfer of User's 2024 prorata share of SVID's irrigation water delivery entitlement from User's Exhibit "A" SVID land to Roza Irrigation District ("RID") to only be used on land within RID's exterior boundaries. The transfer is subject to and limited by the 1/31/45 "Judgment" in <u>KRD</u>, et al. <u>vs. SVID</u>, et al., U.S. Eastern District of Washington Civil No. 21 ("Judgment"), this "Agreement", C:\Users\spark\Desktop\2024 Drought Applications\2024 Transfer Agreement.doc

SVID's policies, rules, regulations and resolutions incorporated herein; and the following conditions:

- 1. The temporary transfer period will be from the date the Water Transfer Working Group approves the transfer and end on September 30, 2024, or sooner as set forth in this "Agreement."
- 2. The volume of water transferred (acre feet) will be the amount of water available at the User's delivery point or points in SVID, measured in cubic feet per second multiplied by the length of time of the transfer.
- 3. No Sunnyside Division irrigation water shall be applied in 2024 to the User's SVID Exhibit "A" land after the effective date of transfer.
- 4. The volume of water temporarily transferred will be adjusted according to the level of proration required in the Sunnyside Division. Temporarily transferred volumes of water will be reviewed and adjusted monthly or more frequently, based on the adjusted Sunnyside Division diversions from the Yakima River.
- 5. This and other temporary, drought condition transfers may be immediately terminated by SVID at any time in SVID's sole determination if:
  - (a) This or other transfers adversely affect SVID's ability to efficiently operate Sunnyside Division irrigation and drainage facilities, hydro-turbine pumping plants and their operation, or SVID landowner/water user adequate and timely water deliveries or water rights, or
  - (b) RID cannot deliver the temporarily transferred water, or
  - (c) Any ground or surface water is in 2024 applied to the User's Exhibit "A" land after the effective date of the transfer, or
  - (d) Any of the transferred water is applied or used on non-RID land outside RID's exterior boundaries.
- 6. RID will pay User \$300.00 per acre-foot for water of the Exhibit "A" irrigated land within 10 days of the effective date of transfer, as long as the transfer pursuant to this Agreement has not been terminated because of User's breach of Section 7(d) above.
- 7. If a User applies ground or surface water within SVID to the Exhibit "A" land during the 2024 irrigation season after the effective date of the transfer, User shall forfeit and repay to SVID all payments made by Roza to User pursuant to this "Agreement". User agrees, if User fails to pay SVID the amount due as required herein, the amount due pursuant to this paragraph shall be included in User's 2025 SVID assessment and irrigation water will not be delivered in 2025 to the

RECEIV to this paragraph.

Exhibit "A" land until the entire assessment including the amount due pursuant to this paragraph, has been fully paid.

- 8. This 2024 temporary, drought condition, supplemental irrigation water transfereshall not establish a precedent, and will not prejudice or adversely affect Sunnyside Division water rights in State of Washington, Department of Ecology vs. Acquavella, et al., Yakima County Superior Court No. 77-2-01484-5, or in any other context, consideration, litigation or proceeding.
- 9. A fee of \$350.00 for each application for processing the water transfer will be billed to RID. User acknowledges and agrees the completed Transfer Agreement submitted to SVID for approval will be evaluated on a case-by-case, first-come, first-serve basis and further acknowledges and agrees the acreage and water accepted for 2024 temporary, conditional, supplemental water transfers are limited to the amounts specified in SVID Resolution 2024-03-01.

The Yakima River Basin is suffering drought conditions this year. Governor Inslee

authorized the Director of the Department of Ecology (Ecology) to declare a drought emergency for

the Basin. The forecast for Total Water Supply Available predicts that the Yakima Project

proratable water users such as Roza Irrigation District are likely to receive only 47% of their

entitlement this irrigation season:

Under these circumstances, time is of the essence in making decisions upon drought

emergency water transfer requests. The Court has adopted a process under the Procedures Relating

to Emergency Conditions provisions of the Court's Pre-trial Order No. 6.

II. Roza Sunnyside Board of Joint Control Water Recovery Projects.

Roza Irrigation District filed a Motion for an Order Pendente Lite requesting approval of a

change in point of diversion for Water Recovery Projects. Return flows from the Roza Irrigation

District will be pumped into the Sunnyside Canal. In exchange for the return flows, the point of

diversion of a portion of the Sunnyside Division water will be transferred from the Sunnyside Dam

to the Roza Dam. The respective points of diversion and the quantities of water to be transferred

are set forth in Exhibit 1.

III. Roza Sunnyside Board of Joint Control Fallowed Land Transfers.

As part of its Motion for an Order Pendente Lite, Roza Irrigation District and the Sunnyside

Division have identified lands within the Sunnyside Division which will remain fallow during the

2015 irrigation season and the saved water will be transferred for use within the Roza Irrigation

District. These transfers involve a change in place of use from the Sunnyside Division to the Roza

Irrigation District and a change in point of diversion from the Sunnyside Dam to the Roza Dam.

This water will be debited from the 2015 annual allocation for the Sunnyside Division (Court

Claim No. 1752) and will be added to the 2015 annual allocation for the Roza Irrigation District

(Court Claim No. 0802). The proposed changes are set forth in Exhibit 1 to the Order Pendente

Lite on Roza Irrigation District's First Motion.
