Notes:

1. February presentation: Kennedy/Jenks will provide an overview of the planning documents and will also provide background about why the Town decided to develop these sewer system planning documents. The presentation will last approximately one hour.
2. May: continuation of public hearing – new comments will be received and addressed. Direction may be provided by the Council to staff at this workshop with regards to what steps to take going forward, if any.

 - Create, adopt and implement sanitary sewer code
 - Determine timing for development of financing for plan
 - Adopt plan following Ecology approval
